Software Asset Management Benefits



Product Usage

Validate what products end users are accessing.



Daily Usage

Identify the average daily usage, as well as highest and lowest usage.



Available Access

Determine actual usage since there will be no denials of access for the length of the pilot.



Usage Reports

Confirm how often users are accessing licenses.



Identify Users

Ability to differentiate between power users and casual users.



Access to Collection Products

Give end users access to the full Collection of products for 30-90 days.



Improve Workflows

Exposure to products that might benefit workflow.
