


Use company network credentials to sign in and have users automatically added to your user list upon their first sign in. SSO enables users to access all applications through a first sign-on.

Seat usage reporting on the Standard plan

All admins can now view "Summary" and "By Product" usage reporting in Seat Usage and export this data to a CSV

Under the "By Product" view, you can see an aggregate summary of how many users per day have used each product.


By clicking on a specific product, you can see details such as frequency of use. For collections, you can see overall collection usage and individual products within it.



Seat usage reporting on the Premium plan


On the Premium plan, admins also have "By user" reporting, which shows frequency of use by an individual user.

The admin can then click on a user for userspecific details such as products used, and usage frequency overtime. If using a collection, you can see aggregate and product-level details.






