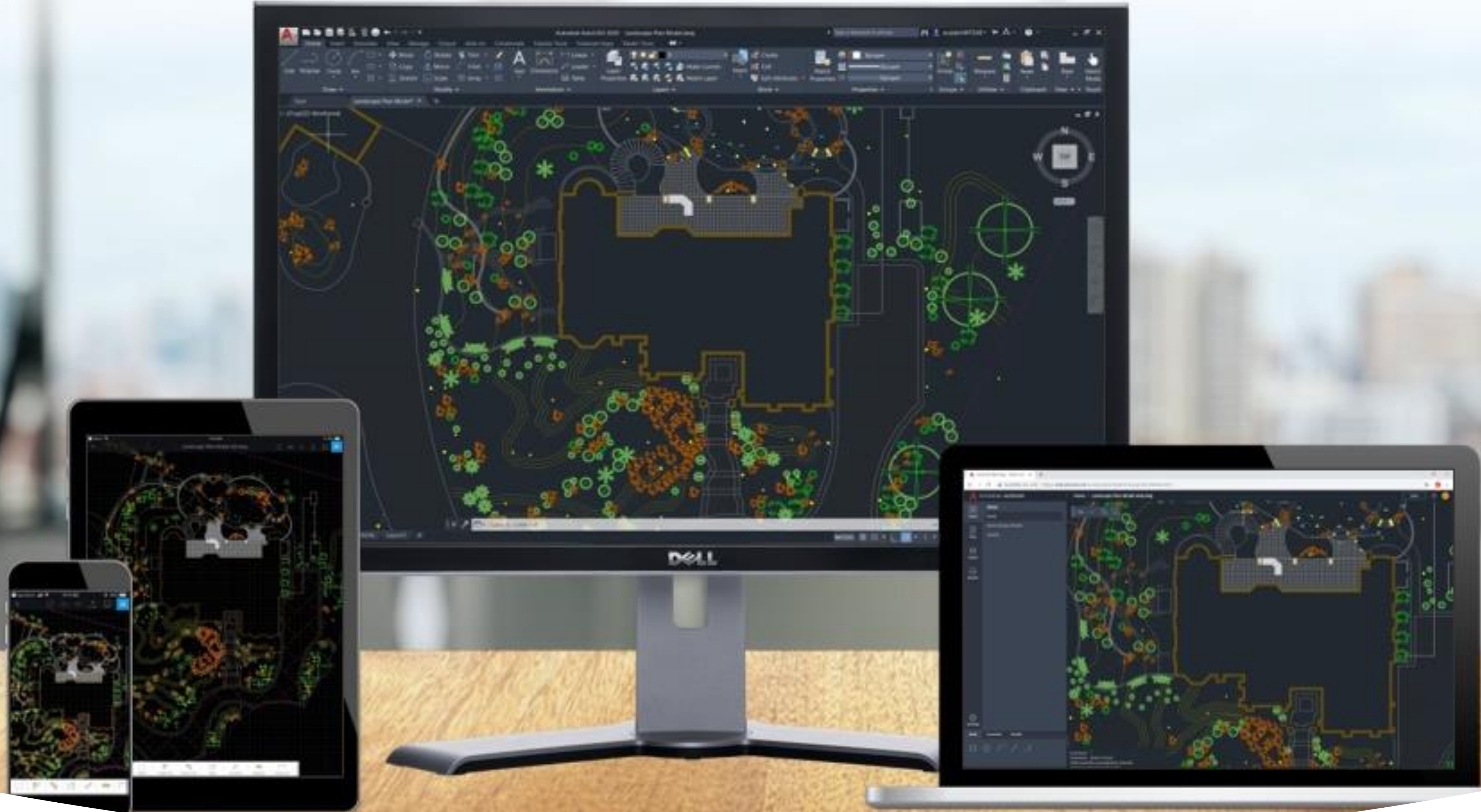

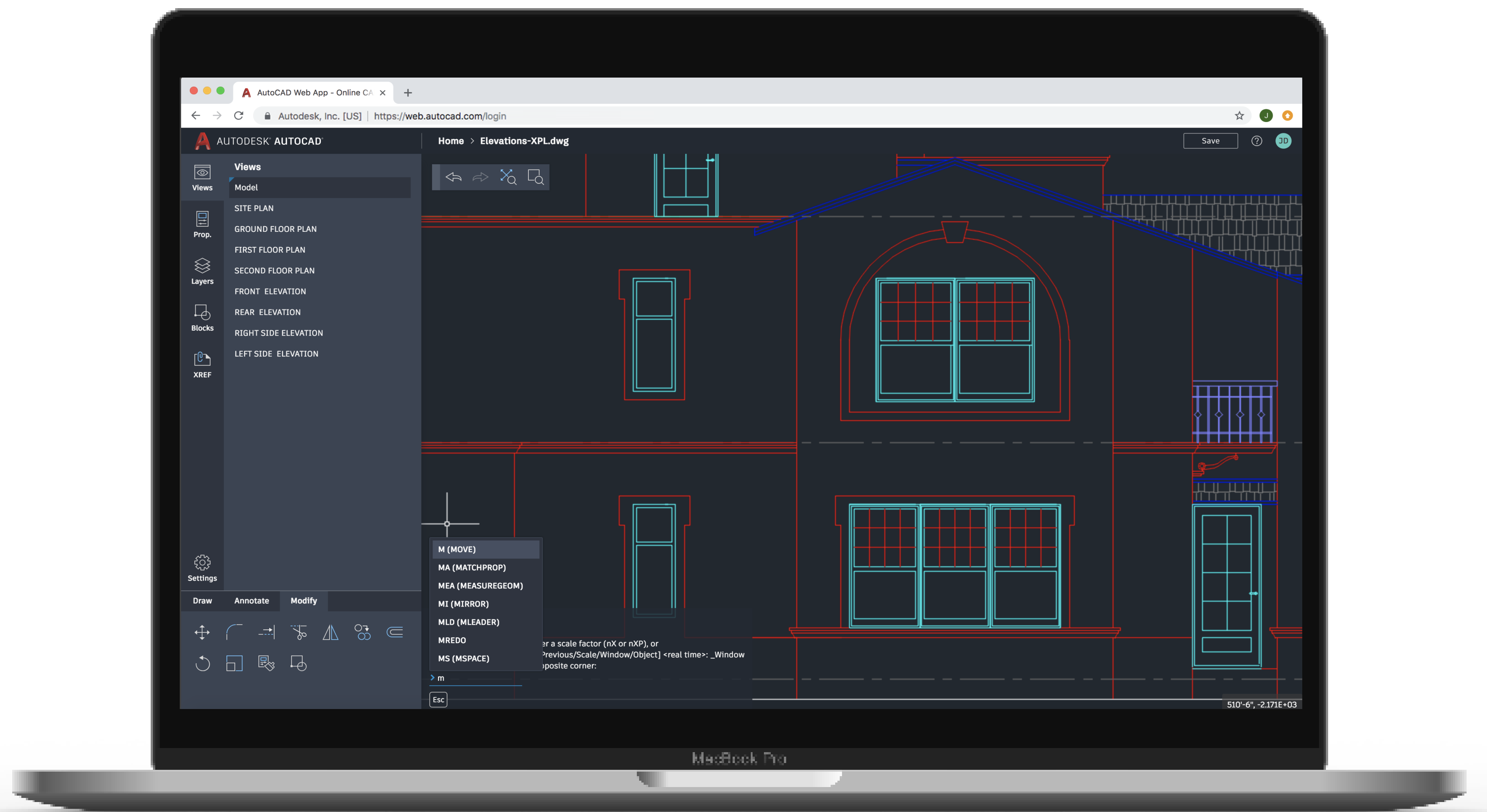

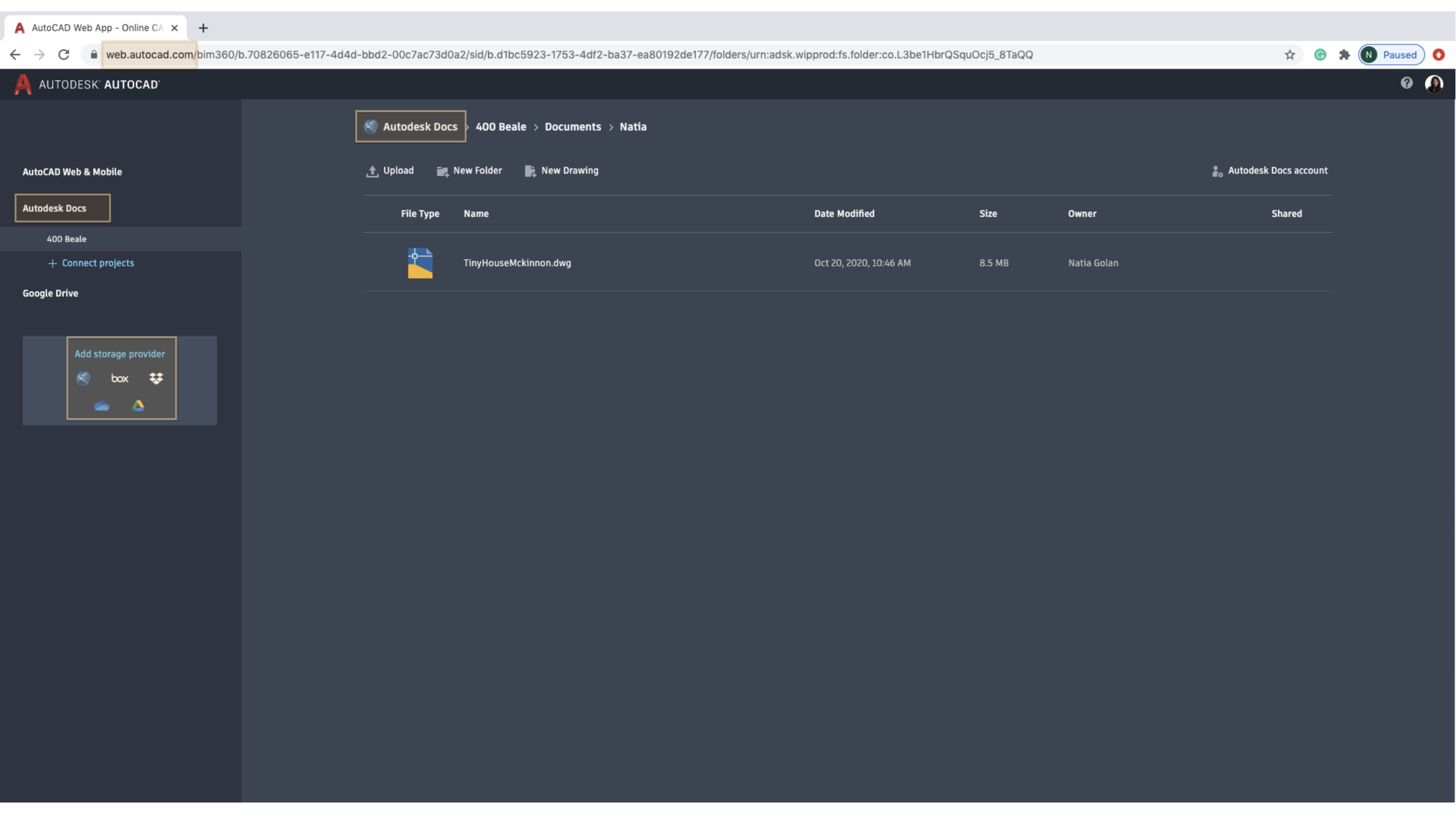

- **Sends a link to a Senior Architect via chat**

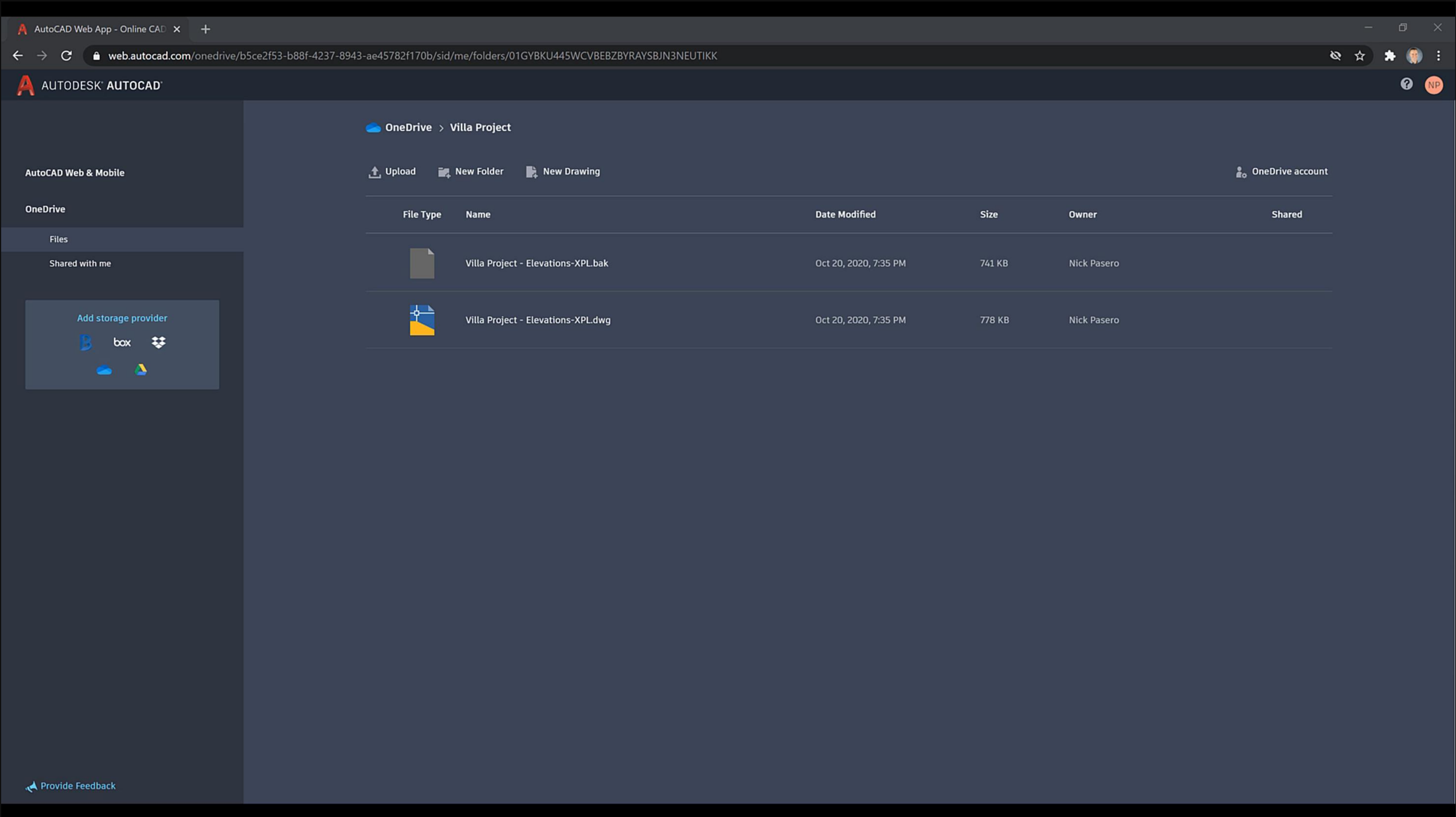




Senior Architect

- Edits the file using the AutoCAD web app

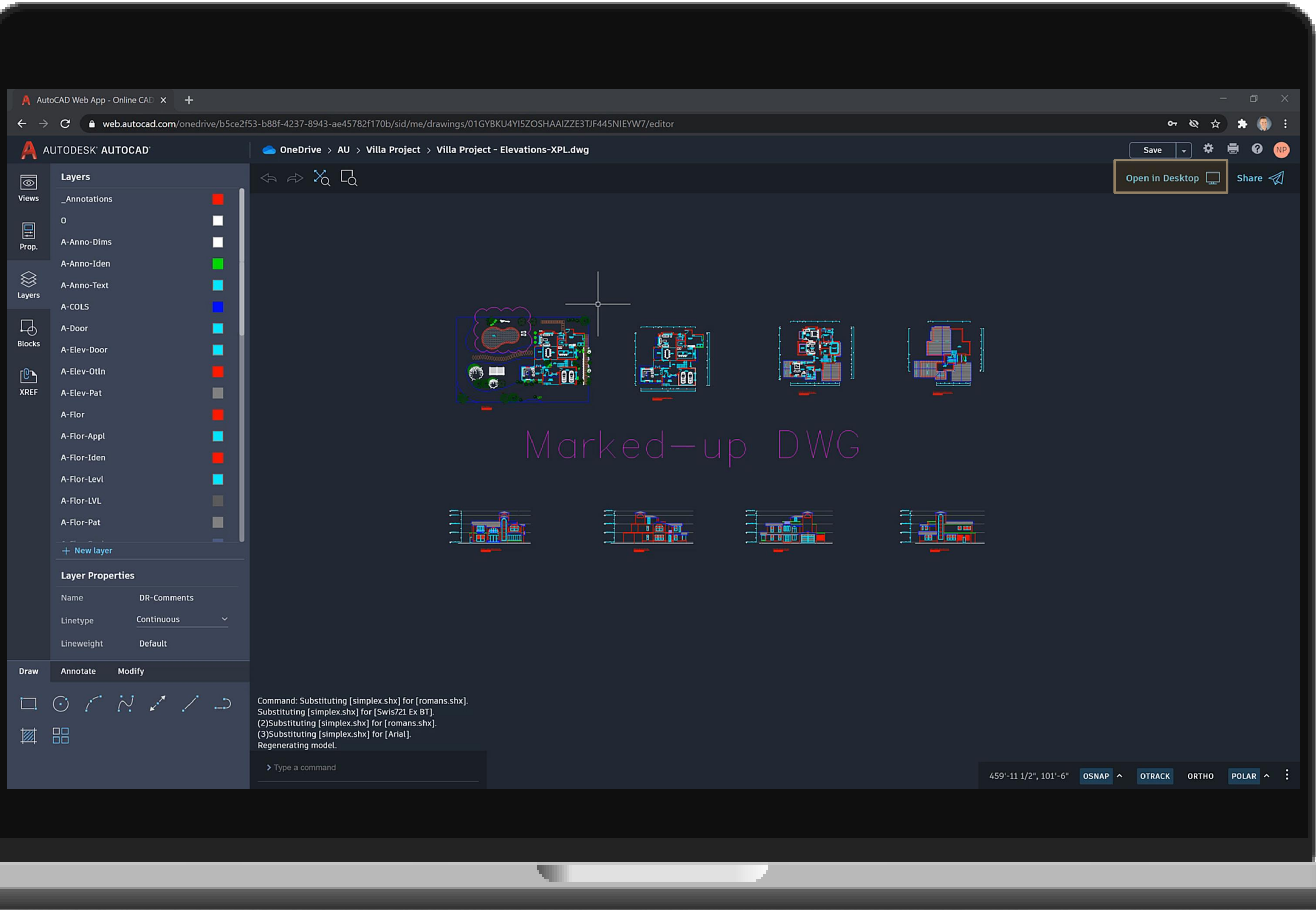

Accurate editing with the AutoCAD crosshair



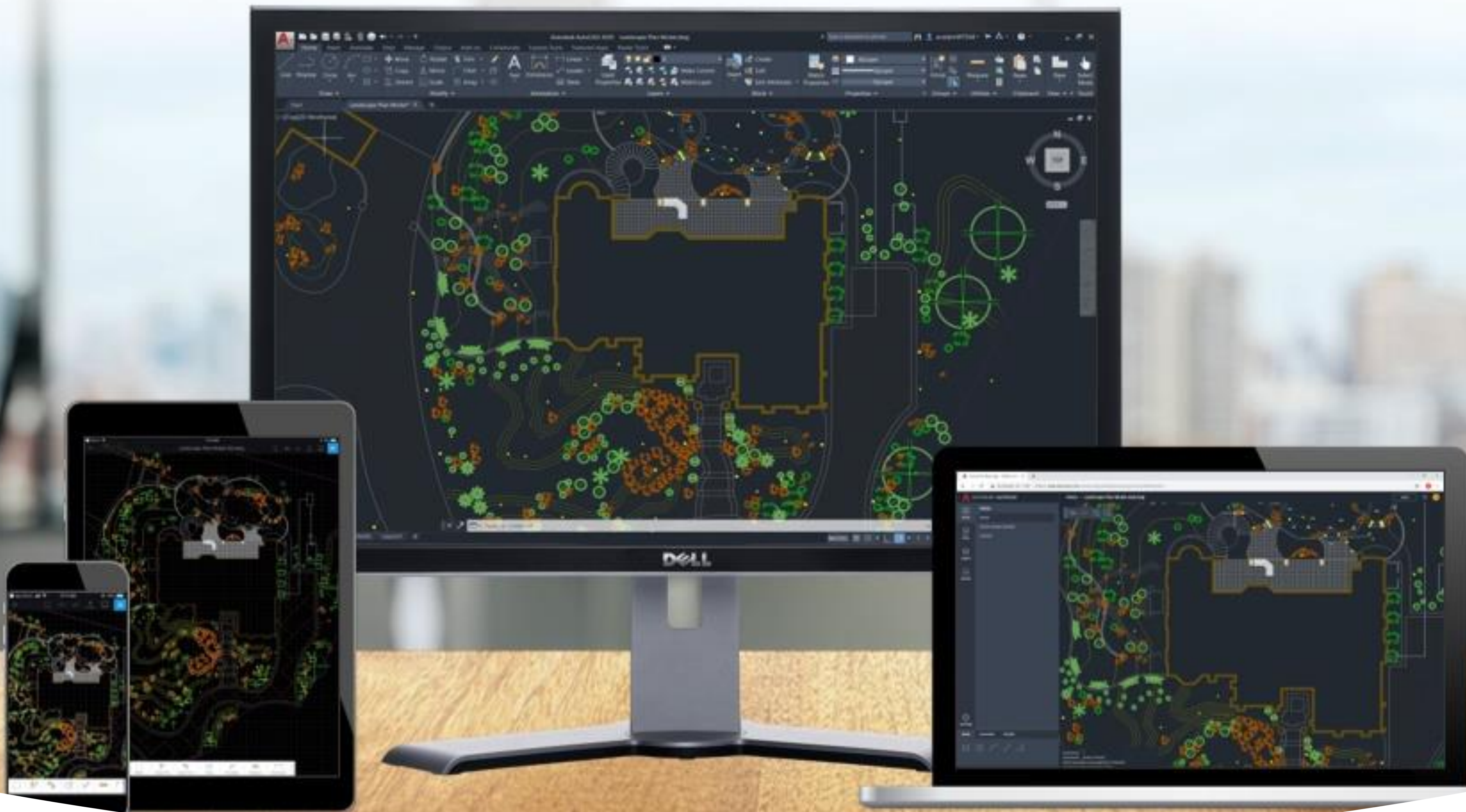

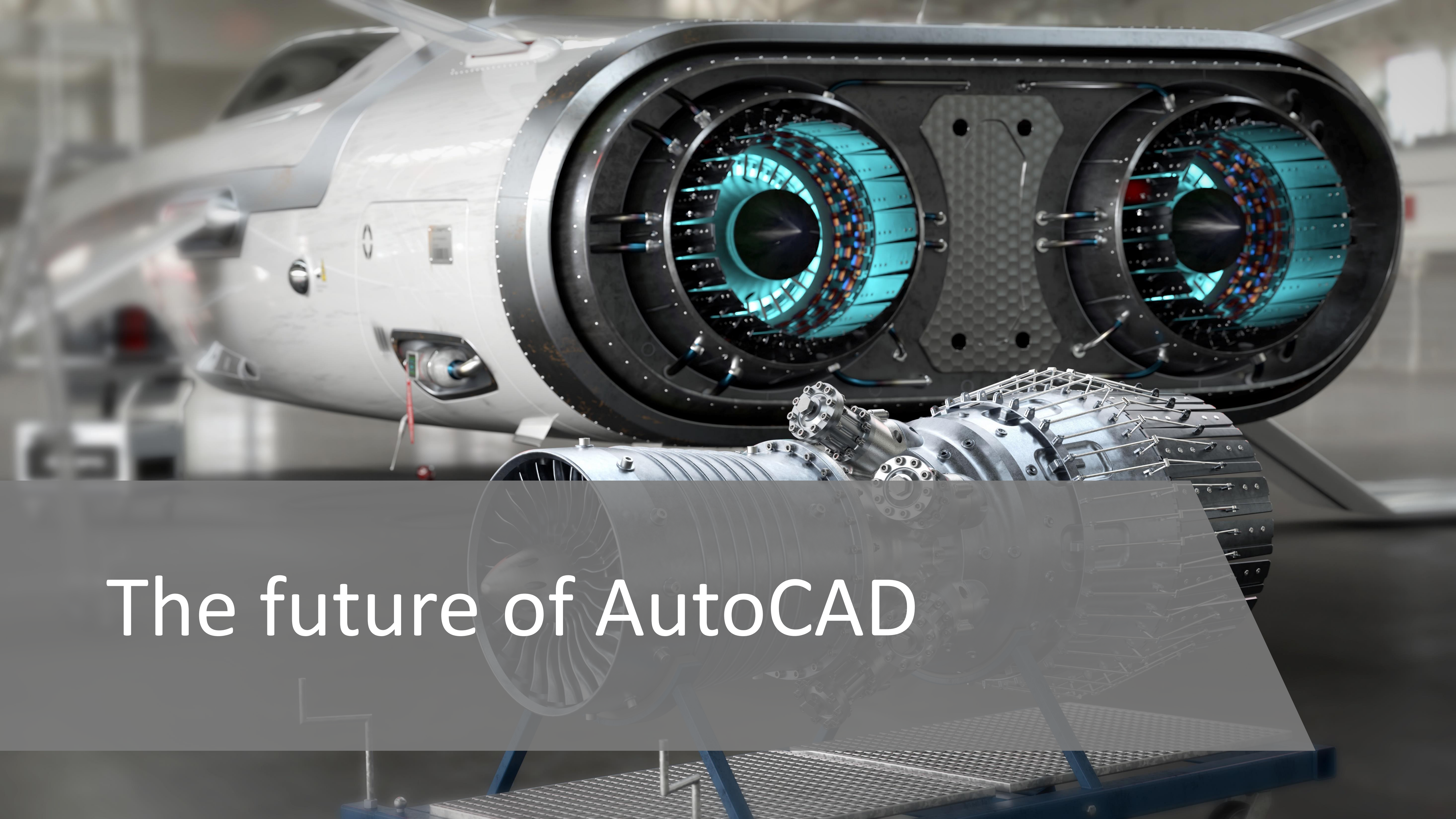
