



- Save to Web & Mobile (SAVETOWEBMOBILE)
- Folders accessible once signed in through AutoCAD
- Cloud-based with access to other cloud providers

Work with the AutoCAD app that most suits your device


Typical examples: -

 AutoCAD mobile app, as it is designed for smaller devices






- Once installed log in with Autodesk account
- Locate relevant folder & open DWG file
- Use Web & Mobile folders
- Alternative cloud providers







(typical functionality using iPhone 12 Pro Max and iPad Pro)

- Zoom in using gestures
- Select text SINGLE TAP
- Edit text DOUBLE TAP
- Text behaves just like MTEXT
- Text height can be edited









(signing out of the **AutoCAD mobile app** to save DWG changes)


Signing out is a THREE step process



- Tap on the 'X'
- Save DWG at prompt




- Tap on the back arrow
- Tap on All Files



- Tap on the hamburger icon
- Tap on Sign Out
- DWG now saved

- Signed in to Autodesk account
- Access to Web & Mobile/cloud
- Open DWG revised in mobile app
- Check changes






