Technology by itself is not the real disruptor.



- Focus on delivering more value to your true customer






The Bell Curve- A Disruption of the Industry




Make a vision tangible

Empowered employees will lead


- Understand the strengths of the individuals on your team

Ceiling is lowered without external engagement



GOALS


- Constantly speak to company's goals with passion and conviction

- Inspire timid or skeptical employees


PROACTIVE MESSAGE

DRIVE THE CHANGE


