### **Bill of Materials**

What is a BOM?

### a List of Things...

The *ingredients* for producing equipment and machinery

The raw material, parts, sub-assemblies, purchased items, and everything else

A BOM provides the list of items engineered, the things to be purchased, and the items that must be manufactured

#### Communication...

a key communication between departments

the single source of truth




## **Maybe Sort Of?**

AutoCAD Bills of Materials

AutoCAD does not have dedicated BOM tools, but there are enough to fake it.

Like what? How about the Count feature? Or the Data Extraction tools? And Blocks with attributes are essentially the same as 3D models with metaproperty data.






## AutoCAD Blocks group objects into a single entity

Attributes are variable-text-metadata




### This wizard extracts information from objects


- Quickly filter only the blocks with attributes
- Adjust display names to merge like objects
- With changes to the drawing use Update All Data Links to update the extraction and associated tables








Adding an Item Column Adding Balloons and Callouts

### Drawings, Vault, and Items

AutoCAD Bills of Materials

You can manage AutoCAD drawings with Autodesk Vault.

However, AutoCAD drawings do not lend themselves to items and Vault will not extract a bill of materials, regardless the drawing's contents.



## **Sharing with Others**

AutoCAD Bills of Materials

- Viewing the drawing (and the inserted table)
- Export the table
- Data extract to a spreadsheet



### The Verdict...

AutoCAD Bills of Materials

AutoCAD does provide basic bill-of-material-liketools for the listing of the components represented in your drawings... if you use blocks with attributes!

#### However:

- the setup of blocks could be time-consuming
- no eloquent method of ballooning
- only a single view of the BOM
- no method to share with other systems








### Extending AutoCAD


- A member of AutoCAD One (you might already have access)
- Part References hold the metadata
- Bill of Materials is a collection of Part References
- Create Balloons from the Part References
- Insert a Parts List into the drawing, a representation of the BOM
